SOCCI 3500 can be used, in solvent applications, for the mildewproofing of textiles and can be diluted with common organic solvents such as mineral spirits, stoddard solvent or naphtha. Where fast drying is required, VMP naphtha or an aromatic similar to xylol is suggested. Compatible waxes, flame retardants, organosols and other textile treatments can also be used in combination with SOCCI 3500 to achieve the desired finish.

Suggested treatment levels for SOCCI 3500 range from 2 to 10% depending upon the nature of the material to be treated and the degree of protection required. Heavyweight goods, particularly those containing water repellents, can be treated at lower levels. Lightweight goods require a higher level of protection.
