The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

## **Proposed Amendment**

Revise First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1

### Conditions

EPA Form 1320-1A (1/90)

Revise the label as follows:

- Revise the Precautionary Statements to include the statement "Wash thoroughly with soap 1. and water after handling."
- Since this product is sold in containers of 5 gallons or more include the following statement, 2. Per PR Notice 93-10, on your larger product labeling:

## ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, and other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit or

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permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

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- 3. Delete the word "Prohibitions" from the Storage and Disposal section.
- 4. Place the statements "Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container." with the Container Disposal section.
- 5. Revise the Storage and Disposal section by creating Pesticide Storage instructions. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for guidance.
- 6. Revise the Pesticide Disposal section to read:

#### PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

7. Revise the Container Disposal section to read:

#### **CONTAINER DISPOSAL**

**PLASTIC**: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

**METAL**: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

8. The EPA Establishment Number must be listed on the label.

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
