VINYZENE BP-5SIL3 has as its carrier low viscosity dimethylsiloxane and is, therefore, compatible with most silicone formulations. Since VINYZENE BP-5SIL3 is a solution, it may be added, as all of the ingredients, during any stage of the mixing process. Temperatures up to 400° F. will not affect the product. Long term mixing or high shear conditions will have no effect.

VINYZENE BP-5SIL3 should be used at levels of 1.0 to 1.67% based on the weight of the finished formulation. For systems such as bathtub caulks or those used on the outside of a building, where excessive leaching occurs, the higher level should be employed.
