## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS

#### AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Inhalation. Causes burns and irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles (or face shield), other gloves and protective clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE NOTICE TO USER

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A level of 1.5% VINYZENE BP-5-2 MEK, based on total weight of formulation, will effectively control the growth of bacteria and mold organisms. This level is recommended for topcoatings for outdoor curtains, wall coverings and similar items. This product should be added to the finished top-coating formulation before use. It should not be used in clothing or other materials in which prolonged contact with the skin is recommended.

For certain vinyl items which may be subjected to extended outdoor weathering, a level of 2.5% VINYZENE BP-5-2 MEK should be evaluated. Such items would include vinyl formulations produced by manufacturers and their agencies for preservation of items subjected to extended outdoor storage. VINYZENE BP-5-2 MEK should replace an equivalent amount of monoglycidyl sebacate in the top-coating formulation.

### FIRST AID

If in Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water.  
If in Eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady stream of water for 15 min.  
If Swallowed: Induce vomiting; drink promptly large quantities of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger or other emetics, such as syrup of ipecac or 2 teaspoons of salt dissolved in a glass of water. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.  
Note to physician: DMS is the antidote of choice.


