PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Danger: Fatal, if swallowed. Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid dust formation. Wear eye protection, gloves and protective clothing.

FIRST AID

If swallowed, give water to drink and induce vomiting until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and seek immediate medical attention. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and discard any contaminated clothing.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not apply directly to water.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not store in the presence of food or feed. OBPA that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved State procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). Container disposal: Completely empty inner liner and consolidate all contaminated liners in a drum. Dispose of drum and inner liner as a hazardous waste in accordance with RCRA. Crush any uncoated drums and incinerate.


Otherwise, directions must be given on the label for obtaining this information from the company. The label must reference the technical bulletin.

- c. The label must also tell the formulators that their labeling for pesticide formulated from your product must conform to that which is currently registered with the Agency.
- d. Since your company has numerous products with OMSA, you are well acquainted with reregistration under the OMSA standard. Reregistration will take place when data requirements have been fulfilled.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
