The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.

Proposed Label Amendment

Label revisions per PR Notice 2001-1

Label Comments

1. Under the Storage and Disposal section add the subheading "Pesticide Storage" and it's language. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for detailed information.
2. In the direction for use instructions, delete the term, "and other pesticides."
3. Add the following statement at the bottom of the first aid statement "**Note to Physician:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."
4. The following statements are suggested types of information that may be included, if applicable:

- technical information on symptomatology;
- use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;
- medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
- company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide

specialized medical advice. **CONCURRENCES**


