- 2. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for the appropriate format and languages. Note that the word "Pesticide" must be added prior to .
- 3. The EPA establishment number must be listed on the label.

4. The First Aid Statement must follow the following order:

IF ON SKIN: IF SWALLOWED: IF INHALED: IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

5. Add the statement "This product is toxic to fish" at the beginning of the environmental hazards statement.
