Proposed Amendment

- revised label per PR Notice 2001-1

Label Comment

1. Revise the Pesticide Storage and Disposal text label to read as follows:

<p style="text-align: center;">STORAGE AND DISPOSAL</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.</p> <p>PROHIBITIONS: Add Prohibitions Statement</p> <p>"PESTICIDE STORAGE: Add storage text here.</p> <p>"PESTICIDE DISPOSAL. : Add storage text here.</p> <p>"CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Add storage text here.</p>
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
- 2. Separate the child signal word Danger and its statements from the First Aid heading and statements.
- 3. The Precautionary Statement must be in the same type size.
- 4. The establishment number must be listed on the label.
