The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

Conditions:

- 1. Revise the 'If on Skin' section by adding the word 'treatment' before the word 'advice'.
- 2. Revise the Precautionary Statements by moving the statement "Harmful if swallowed." following the statement "Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing."
- 3. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement by changing "...public waters..." to "...other waters..."
- 4. Revise the Storage and Disposal section as follows:
 - a. Move the Storage and Disposal section following the Directions for Use section.
 - b. Move the heading 'Pesticide Storage' below the statement beginning "Do not contaminate water, food or feed..." and develop appropriate pesticide storage language. Refer to the Label Review Manual, Chapter 13 for guidance.
 - c. Revise the Pesticide Disposal section by changing "...product or rinsate..." to read "...pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate..."
 - d. Revise the Container Disposal section by developing appropriate residue removal instructions based on the product's formulation and container type. Refer to Label Review Manual, Chapter 13 and PR Notice 2007-4 for guidance.
- 5. Revise "Inert Ingredients" to read "Other Ingredients" in the Ingredients statement section of the label.

- 6. Delete the 'General' section as disposal instructions are addressed in the Storage and Disposal section.
- 7. Move the Conditions of Sale and Warranty section following the Storage and Disposal section.
