

#### DIRECTIONS:

This product is a concentrate and must be diluted with water according to directions and always rinse well immediately with water, when used on porcelain, enamel, such as bathtubs, lavatories and sinks.

#### TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT:

For toilet bowl and urinal cleaning and disinfecting, flush toilet and remove as much water as possible by plunging.
