Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

Container Disposal: For metal containers, triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures. For plastic containers, follow same procedures as for metal, or dispose of by incineration if permitted by State and local authorities.

General: Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

MISTING EQUIPMENT: Use spraying device similar to a Microfog machine or cold aerosol generators such as MICRO-GEN and LECO.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Close room, warehouse or other area to be treated and shut off all ventilating systems. Dispense this product as a fine mist. Use a dosage of one-half ounce per 1000 cubic feet of room space. Do not remain in treated areas. Leave room closed for 1 hour. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Repeat application as necessary for insect control.

IN PRESSURIZED TANK SPRAYERS FOR WETTING CONTACT: To kill the listed insects, the spray should be used as follows at 1000 psi per 1000 square feet of surface area.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and where they are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around windows and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible on the interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom surfaces should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, drawers, furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Weevils: Find and destroy infested package foods. Remove from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects.

To Kill Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package foods. Remove from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects. Use a coarse wet spray to all other areas infested with these insects.

Pay special attention to cracks and crevices in floors, walls and ceiling. Repeat as necessary. To Kill Sowbugs, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and machinery.

IN PRESSURIZED TANK SPRAYERS FOR WETTING CONTACT SPRAYS

To kill the listed insects, the spray should be used as follows at a rate of 1 gallon per 1000 square feet of surface area.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package foods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Apply as a coarse wet spray to all other areas infested with these insects. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices in floors, walls and ceiling. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and machinery.
