SANITIZE solutions are stable. 2 oz. of SANITIZE per gallon of water equals 700 ppm. Do not mix SANITIZE solutions with soap. For sanitizing food equipment or other food contact items, limit concentration to 200 ppm (2.8 oz. per 5 gallons). Sanitize is recommended for use in hospitals, motels and hotels.

### DIRECTIONS

Use at 2 ounces per gallon (use a measuring cup calibrated in ounces). This product will be effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD 10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi. At two ounces per gallon, SANITIZE is effective against Herpes Simplex, Vaccinia Virus and Influenza A on inanimate environmental surfaces. For best results, use SANITIZE with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors, and other hard surfaces. For heavy soils, a pre-cleaning step is recommended. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

**WARNING:** Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**FIRST AID:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. FOR EYES, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before re-use. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of fluid and call a physician immediately.
