CANVAS, ROPE AND WOOD PRESERVATIVE

Clean oil wood preservative, green in color. For open tank, brush or spray application. To control decay, rot, and termites. Fence posts, poles, foundation timbers, and heavy wooden members should be free of bark, dry and well seasoned and immersed in the product for a period of 12 to 48 hours to be effectively preserved. Other types of wood should have at least two flowing coats applied by the brush or spray method, or at least 3 minutes immersion by the open tank method of application. Rope and canvas should be soaked thoroughly by the spray or tank method and dried thoroughly before use. If desired, this preservative may be wrapped out in the form of a preservative.
