Use on Bermuda, Merion Blue, Kentucky Blue, Red Top, Fescue, and Poa. Do not use on Bentgrass lawns when average daytime temperatures are below 60°F.

DO NOT use on St. Augustine, Carpet, Centipede, Bahia, and Dichondra or other Bentgrass putting greens.

1. Be sure soil is moist before treatment.
2. Do not water for 24 hours after treatment, then continue to keep soil moist, especially during hot, dry weather.

### RATE OF APPLICATION

Two applications five to seven days apart are generally needed. On very hot days, using commercial spray equipment both water and WEED-KILLER 120 may be needed if spray equipment can wet grass thoroughly.

WEED-KILLER 120 is effective at the above rate if air temperature average is higher. For temperatures below 60°F. use twice the amount of WEED-KILLER 120 to treat the same area.

To decrease run-off and increase leaf absorption, add 1 quart AEA 341 SURFACTANT with each gallon of WEED-KILLER 120 at the time of application. Clean equipment after use by flushing with water.

Do not spray or allow to drift onto desirable flowers, grass, shrubs, vegetable gardens, or streams. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. Do not store in unsealed containers.

Do not apply with hose-end applicators.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**PROHIBITION:** Do not store near food or food products.
