1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. The Confidential Statement of Formula is not acceptable, since both weights and percentages add up to 100.1. Please submit a corrected formula statement.
- b. Please update the storage and disposal statements per PR Notice 83-3. Your Pesticide Disposal paragraph should read "Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility."
- c. Add the statement "For Industrial/Commercial Use Only" to the label.
- d. A Note to Physician statement must be added to the label, i.e., "Note to Physician. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition occur, Atropine Sulphate is antidotal and may be used in conjunction with 2-PAM."

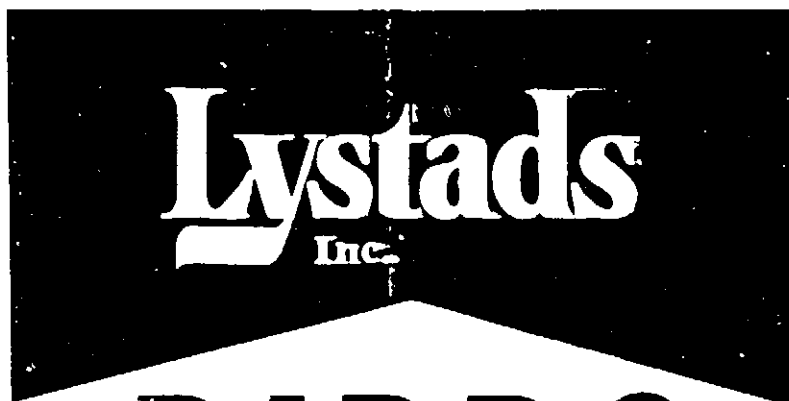

FOOD AREAS — APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY — Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide. In points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduit, motor housings, junction or switch boxes where cockroaches, ants, spiders, silverfish, pantry pests (exposed states of sawtooth grain beetle, flour beetle, rice weevil, cigarette beetle, drugstore beetle) and Indian meal moth hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid the contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Prior to application, de-energize all electrical equipment. After application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the "ON" position.
