PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS — Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREAS — APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY — Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide. In points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduit, motor housings, junction or switch boxes where cockroaches, ants, spiders, silverfish, pantry pests (exposed states of sawtooth grain beetle, flour beetle, rice weevil, cigarette beetle, drugstore beetle) and Indian meal moth hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid the contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Prior to application, de-energize all electrical equipment. After application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the 'ON' position.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

NON FOOD AREAS — Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).
