
AS A SURFACE SPRAY; Far initial clean up of severe insect infestation, dilute at a rate of 1 part concentrate in 14 parts water (8.5 Illuid ounces per gallon). This dilution may not be used in eduble product areas of Federally Inspected meat and soultry plants. In these plants and for normal infestations dilute 1 part concentrate in 29 parts water (4.3 ounces per gallon).

To control cockroeches, ants, silverfish, spiders, crickets, clover mites, these mites, grenery weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, rust red flour beetles, sewtoothed grain beetles, spider beetles, cigarette beetles, drugstore beetles, meet worms, grein mites and cadelless Use a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a course wet spray. DIRECTIONS FOR USE Continued

To control flees, and brews dog status Thoroughly spray Intested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby creaks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, impldings, window and doer fromes and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. To kill flees and faces on cets and dogs, and to obtain protection against reinfestation, dilute at 1 part concentrate to 49 parts water, 2.5 fluid ounces per 1 gallon) and we the animal by dipping and spraying.

AS A SPACE SPRAY: Dilute at a rate of 1 part concentrate to 59 parts water (2 fluid az, per gallon). Apply with mechanical or compressed air equipment (non-thermal) adjusted to deliver a line mist. Close doors and windows and shut off ventifating systems. Keep area closed for at least 10 minutes. Ventilate and sweep up dead insects before reoccupying.

For rapid kill of exposed or accessible stages of other insects named on this label: dibute 1 part concentrate in 5-29 parts water (4 to 25 ounces per gallon). Apply using conventional, mechanical or compressed air equipment (non-thermal), following directions for space spreying. Using mechanical or compressed air equipment (non-thermal) adjusted to deliver a fine imits, apply at a rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Fogger should be aperated 8 to 10 feet away from bads and directed slightly upward over them. Circulating Ians should be left in operation, but for best results refrigeration should be turned off. In packing and conning plants use at a rate of 1 ounce to 2000 cubic feet of space.

OUIDOORS: To kill gypsy moth caterpillers and edults, edult Jepanese beetles and Eastern and forest tent caterpillers on contact; combine 1.0 fluid ounces of concentrate per 1 gallon of water. Apply to insure thorough coverage of upper and tower surfaces.

OR TREES AND SHRUBS: Treat trees and shrubs as soon as insects emerge (usually late spring). Treat leaves, branches and tree trunks evenly, making sure to henetrate dense faliage. Repeat application every 7 days as necessary for control.

ON ROSES AND IN FOWER GARDENS: Treat plants and flowers as soon as insects appear. Spray plants and flowers making sure to penetrate Jense fallage. Repeat application every 7 days or as necessary for control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
