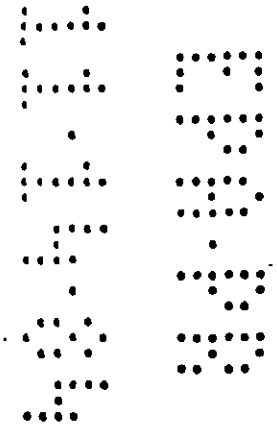

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before space spraying or surface applications.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Use Directions

On Livestock:

To protect cattle and horses from horn flies, house flies, mosquitos and gnats, apply a light mist sufficient to wet surface of the hair. To control stable flies, horse flies and deer flies, apply at a rate of 2 ounces per adult cow or horse, sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection. To control blood-sucking lice, apply to infected areas of the animal using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks if required.
