HOW TO USE CRAMER REPELLENT

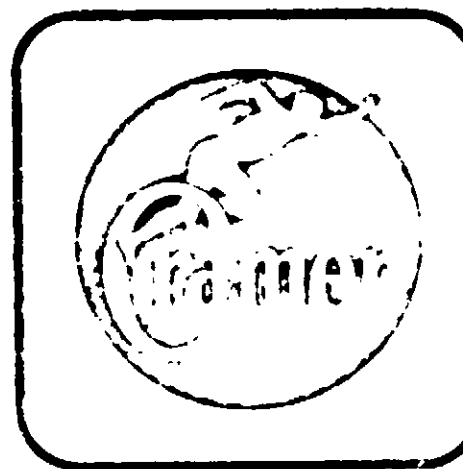
1. Remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12 inches away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. Apply liberally to all exposed skin areas. Repeat whenever insects become annoying. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings of clothing. Repeat as necessary.

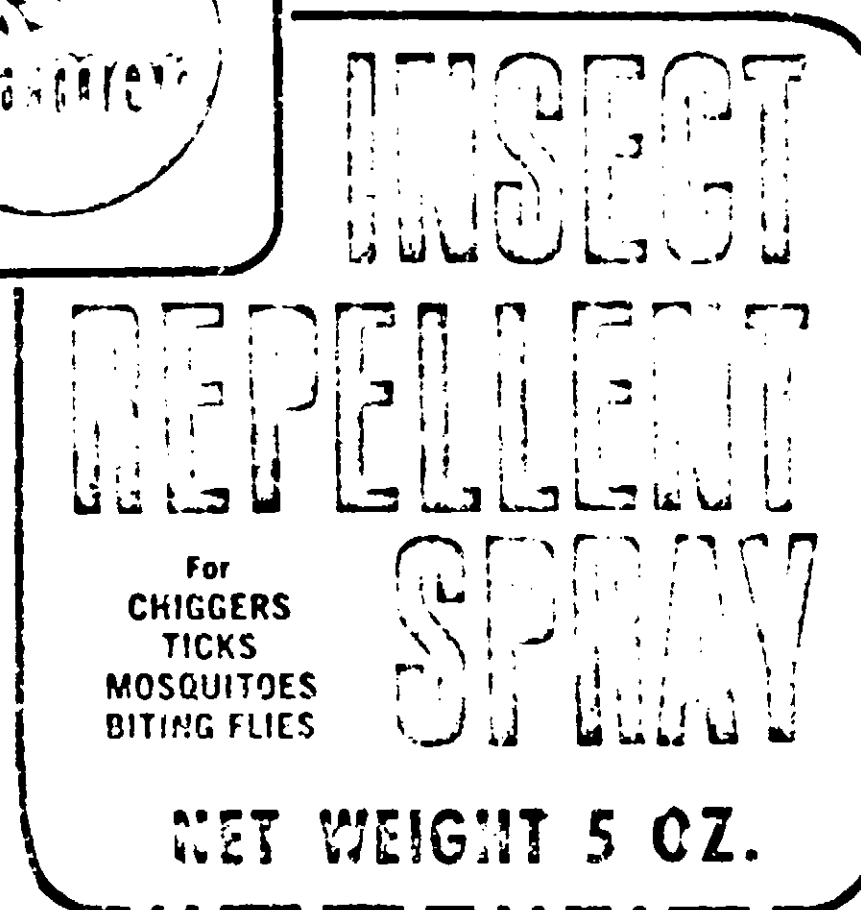

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To repel insects such as mosquitoes, biting flies, gnats, and chiggers, spray lightly on clothing and treat all areas of exposed skin. Give special attention to socks, inside and outside of trouser cuffs, and around other openings in clothing to create a barrier against the insects.

CAUTION:

Do not spray toward eyes or mouth. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on, avoiding contact with the eyes and mouth. Repeat all treatments as necessary.

CAUTION: Do not spray on painted or varnished surfaces, plastics, nail polish or synthetic fabrics such as rayon and nylon. Avoid smearing on goggles or watch crystals.

CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE:

Do not puncture container or throw into fire or incinerator. Do not store in direct sunlight or where temperature exceeds 120° F.

FLAMMABLE MIXTURE: Do not spray near fire or open flame.
