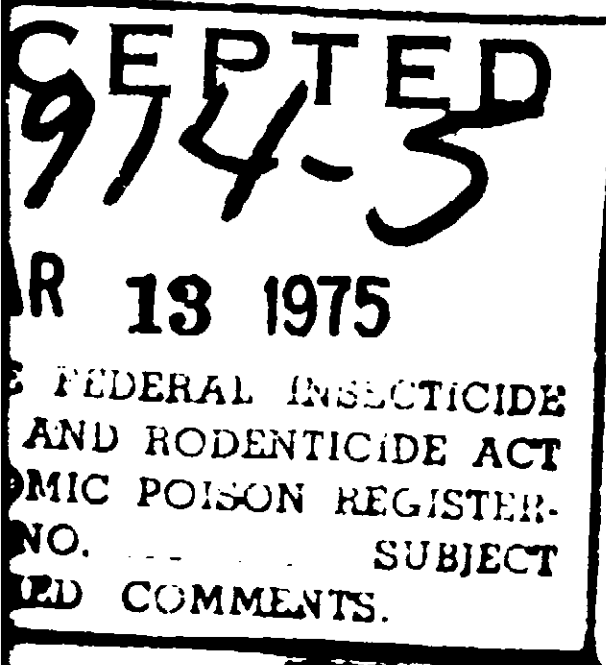

COLD WATER GLASS-WASHING MACHINES

Follow directions of machine manufacturer and local health authorities for adjustment and controlling dosage as recommended below.

DETERGENT-SANITIZER WASH

1. Wash the ware in a solution prepared by adding one (1) ounce of BACTERGENT to 3 gallons of water. (Do not add soap or alkaline detergents.)
2. Rinse ware in germicidal rinse consisting of 1 ounce BACTERGENT for 5 gallons of water, or by another approved method.

NOTE: For best results, scrape food soil off ware before washing. Do not wash silver or silver plate with this material or staining may result.

GERMICIDAL RINSE

1. Wash ware thoroughly in alkaline detergent, soap, or BACTERGENT wash solution.
2. Add one (1) ounce BACTERGENT to 5 gallons of water and rinse ware in this solution.
3. Fresh solutions must be prepared frequently during germicidal treatment.

DANGER:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. **FIRST AID:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
