We have received the above revised labeling submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended. The results of our review of these documents follow.

1. <u>Revised Labeling</u>. The labeling referred to above is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy before you ship product.

- A. Revise the amount of active ingredient to "99.2" and the amount of inert to "0.8."
- B. Replace "Statement of Practical Treatment" with "First Aid"
- C. Add the Storage and Disposal Section as follows:

Storage and Disposal Storage: Store only in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Disposal: Do not reuse empty container [or packaging]. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

D. In the Directions for Use section, replace "to kill" with "kills".

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is provided for your records.

2. <u>Revised CSF</u>. The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), dated June 15, 1998, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is not acceptable for the following reasons:

The upper and lower certified limits of Paradichlorobenzene should be 99.8 and 96.8, respectively.


