DIRECTIONS: Cleaning and Disinfecting Toilet Bowls

Flush toilet. When water becomes still, sprinkle in 1/2 cup of Bowl Cleaner. If discoloration is above water line, pour some of the Bowl Cleaner directly on the side of the porcelain bowl. After standing for a few minutes, the discoloration has been chemically loosened and can be removed by swabbing the solution around the inside of the bowl and under the rim, using a Fuller Bowl Brush. Flush again and rinse bowl brush. Repeat process, as necessary, for badly discolored bowls and heavy lime deposits. Regular use of Fuller Bowl Cleaner prevents stain and lime deposit build-up.

CAUTION: Do not use on tubs, sinks or any enamelled surfaces. Toilet Bowls are porcelain and are not damaged by the Bowl Cleaner. Keep can covered and in a dry place.

DIRECTIONS: Cleaning and Disinfecting Toilet Bowls
Flush toilet. When water becomes still, sprinkle in 1/4 cup of Bowl Cleaner. If discoloration is above water line, pour enough of the Bowl Cleaner directly on the side of the porcelain bowl. After standing for a few minutes, the discoloration has been chemically loosened and can be removed by scrubbing the surface around the inside of the bowl and under the rim, using a Toilet Bowl Brush.
