Your Application Dated June 19, 1990

The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, removing the active ingredient MGK R-11 and increasing the percentage of another active ingredient, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Submit the product-specific product chemistry and data matrix for the new formulation.
2. Based on the current Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 20, 1990, the product will not meet the label claim for the active ingredients. The label claim for Deet is 6.65% plus 0.35%; however, the CSF claims 6.40% for all of Deet. The label claim must be the same as the certified lower limit reported in the CSF. Submit a revised CSF or correct the label so that they agree.
3. The statement "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children" must appear directly above the signal word "Caution."

4. Add the following precautionary labeling:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

For external use only. Harmful if swallowed. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, lips or open cuts. Do not expose treated skin or clothing to fire, sparks or flame. Do not allow children to rub eyes if hands have been treated.

5. Add the following Statement of Practical Treatment:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT


If Swallowed: Consult a physician or Poison Control Center.

If On Skin: May cause skin reactions in rare cases. If so, wash thoroughly with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If In Eyes: Wash with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

6. Precede the statement "Do not use or store near heat or open flame" by the "Physical and Chemical Hazards" heading.
7. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.
