Dear Ms. Wagle:

The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act, as amended, making a number of labeling changes adding an additional fragrance vender is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1) Change the First Aid section to read:

IF IN EYES:

- * Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- * Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing.
- * Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF YOU SUSPECT A REACTION TO THIS PRODUCT:

- * Discontinue use.
- * Take off contaminated clothing.
- * Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- * Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

HOT LINE NUMBER

In case of emergency call toll free(insert number).

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.

2) Change the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

“Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.”

3) Change the Storage And Disposal section to read:

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store the product in a cool and dry place. Keep out of reach of children.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

IF EMPTY: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.

This product is not being re-registered at this time since a RED has not been issued for all the active ingredients in the formulation.

A stamped copy of the revised label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the revised finished label before the product is released for shipment under this amended label.


The information submitted by your supplier of the fragrance, F-82140 is acceptable.
