DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake before using. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, FLYING MOTHS, GNATS, HOUSE FLIES, AND BEES.

Space spray treatment. Close room, warehouse, or other area to be treated and shut off all ventilation systems. Dispense product as a fine mist. Do not remain in treated areas. Leave room closed for 0.5 hour. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Repeat application as necessary for insect control.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS, CARPET BEETLES AND OTHERS LISTED BELOW:

Contact spray treatment. Contact as many insects as possible in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room suspected of harboring the pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and wherever the pests are suspected of hiding. Repeat as necessary. For ant control, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails, and other areas of entry. For carpet beetle control, spray both the interior and exterior of upholstered furniture and also spray the top and bottom of rugs and carpets. Spray shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever the insects are seen or suspected. For control of exposed forms of confused flour beetle, rice weevil, and sawtoothed grain beetle, find and destroy infested package foods. Remove all other pantry items. Spray the shelves to kill any insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. For flea and tick control, remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Treat dogs and cats with a registered flea & tick control product before allowing them to enter the treated area.

FABRIC TREATMENT FOR THE FOLLOWING PESTS- MOTHS (ADULT AND LARVAE) & CARPET BEETLES (ADULT AND LARVAE):

Brush articles clean, air, and remove persistent spots and stains by dry cleaning. Spray garment thoroughly from a distance of 2 feet. Place treated article in darkened closet or other darkened storage area. Spray insides of closet or storage area for 30 to 40 seconds before storing treated articles. Repeat treatment every 6 months or as needed. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in cool area away from heat and open flame under lock and key inaccessible to children, pets, and persons unfamiliar with its use.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

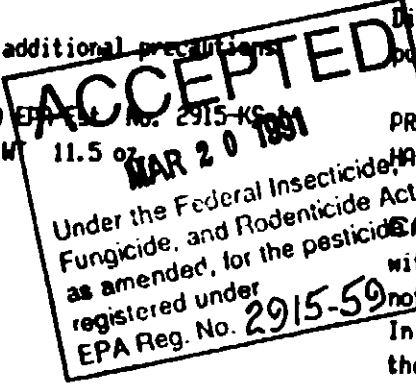
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving, or storage areas. In home use, food processing surface should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before treatment. Avoid breathing of spray mist and contact with skin and eyes. This pesticide is toxic to fish.
