### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use as a spot treatment on localized surface areas only.

TO OPERATE: Holding the can upright, with orifice directed toward surface to be treated, press actuator button.

TO KILL: COCKROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, EARWIGS: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

TO KILL: BROWN DOG TICKS: Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

TO CONTROL: FLIES, MOSQUITOES: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of windows and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

### STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store in cool dry place inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Do not smoke while using.
