DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

To Kill Flies, Flying Moths, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Wasps: Close all windows and doors and spray upward into the center of the room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for the average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

To Kill Ants, Crickets, Roaches, Silverfish, Waterbugs: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails, over window and doorsills and other locations. Repeat as necessary for control.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.
