The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following label changes.

- 1. Based on the statements in the Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals section, add the following statements to the first aid section:
 - If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

 Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- 2. The first aid statements must appear in the order of most server routes of exposure first. Therefore revise the statements so that the If Swallowed, If on Skin and If Inhaled statements appear as the first, second and third statements in the first aid section.

You must submit two (2) final printed label before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

INDUSTRIAL INSECT SPRAY IN

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before use. Hold container upright.

To Kill Flies, Flying Moths, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Wasps: Close all windows and doors and direct spray upward into the center of the room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for the average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying.

To Kill Ants, Crickets, Roaches, Silverfish, Waterbugs: Contact as many insects as possible with spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of food. Do not apply while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination.

FIRST AID

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
