Industrial Insect Spray III  
EPA Registration Number 2915-65  
Your Submission Dated August 14, 2003

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following label changes.


1. Based on the statements in the Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals section, add the following statements to the first aid section:

**If Swallowed:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

2. The first aid statements must appear in the order of most server routes of exposure first. Therefore revise the statements so that the If Swallowed, If on Skin and If Inhaled statements appear as the first, second and third statements in the first aid section.

You must submit two (2) final printed label before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.
