EMERGENCY TREATMENT

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

WARNING SYMPTOMS OF POISONING include: drowsiness, dizziness, headache, blurred vision, pinpoint pupils, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal cramps, constipation, and unconsciousness.

TREATMENT: At first sign of poisoning, give large amounts of water to drink. Do not induce vomiting. If patient is unconscious, do not give water. If patient is breathing, administer oxygen. If patient is unconscious, administer resuscitation. Clean object that caused poisoning from skin and clothing. If eyes are affected, flush eyes with large amounts of water. If skin contact occurs, wash skin with large amounts of water. If irritation continues, call physician or poison control center.

For medical treatment of parathion poisoning, see "Parathion" in "Treatment of Agricultural Pesticide Poisonings." If symptoms of poisoning continue after removal of product from body, seek medical attention. Do not delay treatment. Do not induce vomiting if patient has taken more than one-half hour after exposure until the time of diagnosis where no吐物物 has been swallowed as determined by blood test.

ANTIDOTE AND FIRST AID TREATMENT

ATROpine IS THE EMERGENCY ANTI-HERPETAL FOR ANTICHOLINERGIC POISONING.
Consult your physician about obtaining atropine tablets or atropine sulfate tablets
for emergency use. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY IN CASE OF SUSPECTED
POISONING.

INTERNAL: If the material has been taken internally, it must be removed. This may be done by introducing a catheter (to collect urine, for example) or by a tablespoonful of salt to a glass of water). **NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON.**

EXTERNAL: If the material has been applied to the skin, immediately remove patient from the vicinity of the Parathios. Remove all contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and running water. If the material gets into the eyes, wash immediately with running water for at least ten minutes. IF WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR: Administer two 1/100 grain atropine tablets immediately. NEVER ADMINISTER ATROPINE UNLESS WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR (see WARNING SYMPTOMS under Note to Physician). Keep patient prone and quiet. Start artificial respiration immediately if patient is not breathing. Transport the patient immediately to the nearest physician.
