For a residual wall, floor and machinery spray in grain elevators, in treating truck beds, box cars and ships' holds before loading grain (corn, barley, oats, rye and wheat), apply 1 gallon of Red-Top Premium Grade Malathion Grin Protectant per 25 gallons of water making thorough application. Before applying spray, clean elevators and box cars thoroughly. Remove and burn all sweepings and debris. Wear a respirator.
