

# **THIOFENOL-SURVOR 50 DUST**

**Use 10 lbs. per acre to control ALICE BUG, COTTON STING BUG, LYGUS BUGS, BOLLWORM and CABBAGE WORM. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. Do not apply to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals.**

**Use 10 to 15 lbs. per acre to control CABBAGE LOOPER, COTTON STING BUG, LYGUS BUGS, BOLLWORM and CABBAGE WORM. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. Do not apply to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.**

**Onions: Use 30 lbs. per acre to control COTTON STING BUG, LYGUS BUGS, BOLLWORM and CABBAGE WORM. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. Do not apply after bulb begins to open. Do not poison water or dairy animals in treated fields.**

**Tomatoes: Use 10 lbs. per acre to control WORMS, FLEA BEETLE, COLORADO POTATO BEETLE and WHITEFLY. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. Do not spray within 1 day of picking.**

**Plums: Use 25 to 30 lbs. per acre to control CHERRY WORM. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not use on cherries if injury is likely to occur.**

**Peaches: Use 20 lbs. per acre to control CABBAGE LOOPER, CHERRY PEACH APHIS, SUMMER BACK MOTH LARVAE and CABBAGE WORM. Do not apply within 3 applications of last spraying. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Remove outside leaves at harvest. Do not feed fruit waste to livestock.**

**Prune vines: Use 30 to 35 lbs. per acre to control THE APHID and THE WEEVIL. Do not feed treated vines or prunings to dairy or other animals.**

**TOMATOES: Use 30 to 35 lbs. per acre to control FLEA BEETLE, COLORADO POTATO BEETLE, LEAFHOPPERS, APHIDS, POTATO TUBERWORM, LIMA-FOOTED PLANT BUG, SOUTHERN ALLIGATOR GREEN BIRD BUG, POTATO FROGLID and MEXICAN CORN Borer. Apply as needed to harvest.**

**Use 20 lbs. per acre to control FLEA BEETLE and GREEN PEACH APHID. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.**

**Strawberries: Use 20 lbs. per acre to control STRAWBERRY APHID and SPIDER SPITTLEBUG. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest. Do not apply at intervals of less than 15 days or more than twice during any 35-day period.**

**TOMATOES: Use 20 lbs. per acre to control COLORADO POTATO BEETLE, FLEA BEETLE, APHIDS and WHITEFLY. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. Do not apply within 1 day of picking.**

**Walnuts: Use 40 lbs. per acre to control WALNUT APHIDS. Repeat as required to maintain control. Do not apply after husk split.**
