- **BEANS:** Use 30-40 lbs. per acre to control ANTHRACNOSE and DOWNY MILDEW. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest. Apply when disease threatens; repeat at 4 to 6 day intervals as needed.
- CABBAGE: Use 30-40 lbs. per acre to control ALTERNARIA LEAF SPOT and DOWNY MILDEW. Apply 7 to 10 days after planting. Apply when disease threatens; repeat weekly as needed. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
- CARROTS: Use 30-40 lbs. per acre to control ALTERNARIA and CERCOSPORA LEAF SPOT. Apply when disease threatens; repeat every 7 to 10 days.
- CELERY: Use 35-40 lbs. per acre to control EARLY and LATE BLIGHT. Apply when plants are established in the field; repeat as frequently as required (weekly under average conditions; every 3 to 5 days under severe conditions). Remove residues by washing, stripping and trimming. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

DIRECTIONS (Continued)

- CUCUMBERS, MELONS and SQUASH: Use 30-40 lbs. per acre to control ANGULAR LEAF SPOT, ANTHRACNOSE and DOWNY MILDEW. Apply as soon as plants begin to run or when disease threatens; repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest.
- **GRAPES:** Use 25 lbs. per acre to control BUNCH ROT. Make first application when berries are starting to break color and repeat every 14-21 days for three applications. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
- LETTUCE and ENDIVE: Use 30 lbs. per acre to control DOWNY MILDEW. Apply when disease appears; repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals under average conditions, 3 to 5 days when disease conditions are severe. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest. Remove residues from head lettuce by stripping and trimming, and from leaf lettuce and endive by washing or other effective means.
- ONIONS: Use 30-40 lbs, per acre to control BLAST, DOWNY MILDEW and PURPLE BLOTCH. Apply when first spots appear; repeat weekly as needed.
- **POTATOES:** Use 40-50 lbs. per acre to control EARLY and LATE BLIGHT. Apply as soon as plan's are 2 to 6 inches high; repeat at 5 to 10 day intervals as long as blights threaten.
- TOMATOES: Use 40-50 lbs. per acre to control ANTHRACNOSE, EARLY and LATE BLIGHT, GREY LEAF SPOT (Stemphyllium), and SEPTORIA LEAF SPOT. Apply when fruit of first clusters is well formed; repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do not use on young seedlings in green houses as injury may occur. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest
