

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: Immediately remove all contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and warm water.

Apply at petal fall and every 10 to 14 days thereafter until control is achieved. Do not apply later than 21 days on apples and 14 days on pears, before harvest. Do not apply more than 900 gallons of dilute spray per acre. Do not apply when trees or a substantial number of weeds in the orchard are in bloom.
APRICOTS, CHERRIES, NECTARINES, PEACHES, PLUMS: Use 1/2 pint per 100 gallons of water to control ORIENTAL FRUIT MOTH, PLUM CURCULIO, FRUIT TREE LEAFROLLER, RED SPIDER, EUROPEAN RED, PACIFIC, TWO-SPOTTED and WILLAMETTE MITES. 1. Delete the following wording from the Precautionary Statements before you release the product for shipment:

Wear clean, heavy rubber boots, and clean waterproof or freshly laundered protective clothing (coveralls, cap), and goggles when applying or handling. Destroy and replace gloves frequently. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the Provisions of 30 CFR Part II.

2. Add the following statement to the label: "For aerial applications, flagging must be by fully automated mechanical means or by humans working in totally enclosed vehicles.

3. As per FR Notice 83-2, the reentry interval for "Trion 6 Spray" must be changed to 48 hours.
