

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS — DANGER: Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear a mask or respirator of a type suitable for protection against phosphamidon liquid. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and hot water before re-use. Keep all unprotected persons out of operating areas or vicinity where there may be danger of drift.

ANTIDOTE: If Swallowed — Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or blunt object. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. In addition, mixer/loaders must wear a chemical-resistant apron. During equipment repair and cleaning, the protective suit need not be worn. If overhead exposure is likely, such as when flagging during aerial application, a hood or wide-brimmed hat must be worn.

RE-ENTRY INTERVAL

Re-entry into treated areas is prohibited for 48 hours after the end of application, unless the protective clothing specified on this label for early entry is worn.

FOR EARLY RE-ENTRY INTO TREATED AREAS: Use protective suit of one or two pieces covering all parts of the body except head, hands and feet, chemical-resistant gloves, chemical-resistant shoes (or chemical-resistant shoe coverings or chemical-resistant boots).

RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until 48 hours after the end of application. Because certain states may require more restrictive re-entry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

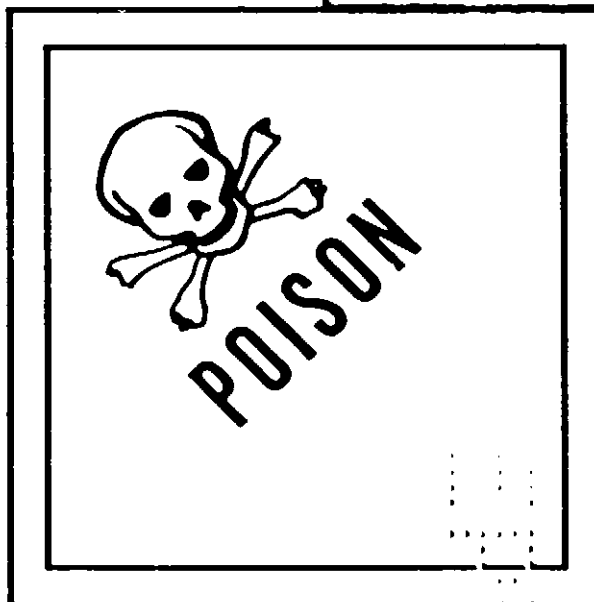
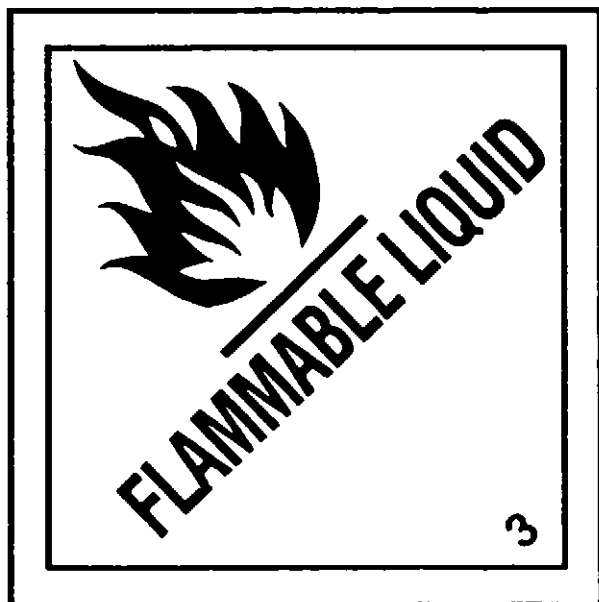
