

DANGER. This material is swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get material on skin or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water. Wear a mask or respirator of a type approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for Methyl Parathion + Endosulfat mixture. Keep children, pets and beneficial animals out of operating areas or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be reentered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

USAGE CAUTION

Do not use in areas where wind is blowing toward houses, roads and streams. Best results are obtained when used in calm or light wind and in clear, sunny conditions. Favor drift from a downwind. Do not use in areas where there is a high water table. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Apply to crops only as specified on the label.

USE OR WASTE DISPOSAL: Do not use on or near pastures, lawns, or non-crop land away from water courses. Do not use in areas where there are children and furry animals with wastes.
