You may distribute products bearing old labels/labeling for 12 months from receipt of this letter or your next printing of the label, which ever occurs first.

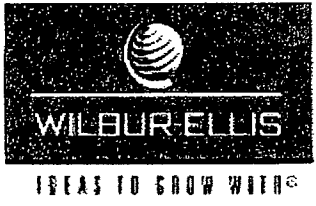

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or dust. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause an allergic reaction in some people. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Keep out of reach of domestic animals. Do not use on humans, household pets or livestock. Do not contaminate ornamental fish ponds.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

ENGINEERING CONTROLS

This product is formulated into a Lock & Load container system that meets the definition of a closed loading system in the Worker Protection Standard for Agricultural Pesticides [40 CFR 170.240(d)(4)]. Loaders using the closed loading system packaging must:

- wear the personal protective equipment required for loaders using engineering controls; and
- be provided and must have immediately available for use in an emergency, such as a broken package, spill, or equipment breakdown, chemical-resistant footwear and the respirator specified for handlers not using engineering controls.

Applicators using motorized ground equipment must use an enclosed cab that meets the definition in the Worker Protection Standard for Agricultural Pesticides [40 CFR 170.240(d)(5)] for dermal protection. In addition, applicators must:

- wear the personal protective equipment required in the PPE section of this labeling for handlers using engineering controls;
- either** wear the respirator specified for handlers not using engineering controls **or** use an enclosed cab that is declared in writing by the manufacturer or by a government agency to provide at least as much respiratory protection as the respirator specified for handlers not using engineering controls;
