GENERAL INFORMATION

NU-FLOW ND is a seed treatment fungicide which protects against seedling diseases, damping-off, and other seedling diseases. Rhizoctonia, Phythium, and other fungi which cause seedling diseases and seedling development of cotton. NU-FLOW ND is a seed treatment fungicide which is pumped or poured directly into the cotton seed.

Label Treated Seed: This seed is treated with NU-FLOW ND. Do not use in food, feed, or any other plants except plants. Add appropriate information to any other label treatment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Prohibitions:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Apply 7.5 to 19.4 fluid ounces of NU-FLOW ND per 100 lbs. of cotton seed. (In Cal. use 14.5 to 19.4 fl. oz.)

NU-FLOW ND may be diluted with water, provided the recommended amount of product is applied.
