NU-FLOW ND is a ready-to-use flowable that can be pumped or poured directly into the cotton seed treater.

Label treated seed: "This seed is treated with NU-FLOW ND fungicide. Do not use for food, feed, oil production or any other purpose except planting." In California, do not graze plants grown from treated seed. Add appropriate information for any other chemical treatment.

Always use NU-FLOW ND with an EPA-approved dye or colorant that imparts an unnatural color to the seed.

East of the Rocky Mountains, apply 5.0 to 19.7 fluid ounces of NU-FLOW ND per 100 pounds of cottonseed.
