
The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you:

2. Revise the restricted entry interval to 24 hours. This interval is required for all products in Toxicity Category II.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**GENERAL**

NU-FLOW D is recommended for use to protect against seed/seedling (corn, Pythium), which impair good seed and beans. NU-FLOW D is a ready-to-use product for use in seed treatments.

**NOTE:** Federal Law requires that bag following information: "This seed has been treated with a fungicide. Do not use treated seed for plants grown from treated seed. In other words, do not plant."

The purchaser of this product is responsible for ensuring that the product is used in accordance with the label. Refer to 21 CFR, Part 40 CFR, Part 160.1001.

Do not apply this product through any type of nozzle.

**COTTON and BEANS**

Apply NU-FLOW D at the rate of 4.0 lbs. or fuzzy cotton seed (in California use 100 lbs. of beans).

Use only higher rates under conditions of reduced efficiency.

NU-FLOW D may be diluted with water. Do not dilute.

Include an approved dye during treatment. Do not use in a manner that will contaminate seed.

**STORAGE**

1. Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed.
2. Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixtures, or empty containers must be done in accordance with applicable state and federal laws. Do not reuse or reuse containers for anything other than pesticide.
