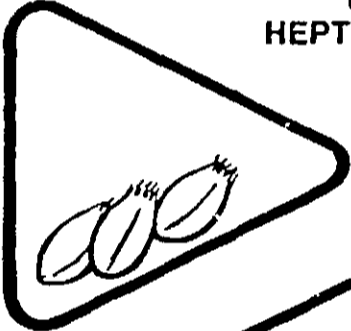

spreading agent to give even seed coverage and a red dye to distinguish treated seed.
WAYVAN controls a wide range of insects as follows: Wireworm, False Wireworm,
Seed Corn Beetle, Southern Corn Rootworm, Kafir Ant, Seed Corn Maggot.

WARNING

Avoid contact with WAYVAN PLUS. It may be fatal if swallowed. Do not breathe
vapors. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or
smoking. Clean clothing should be used daily. Wear clean synthetic rubber gloves
