

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or, if available, by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

This pesticide may be fatal to dogs or other pets if eaten. Keep pets out of treated area.

RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

4. Storage: Store in original container only and keep sealed. Store in closed storage areas. Use caution when moving, opening, closing or pouring.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

Apply broadcast or band treatment by ground only. Use only band treatments after formation of edible plants. Do not contaminate edible parts.

Rate: Apply at rate of 30 to 60 pounds per acre. Repeat applications as necessary but not more than once a week.
