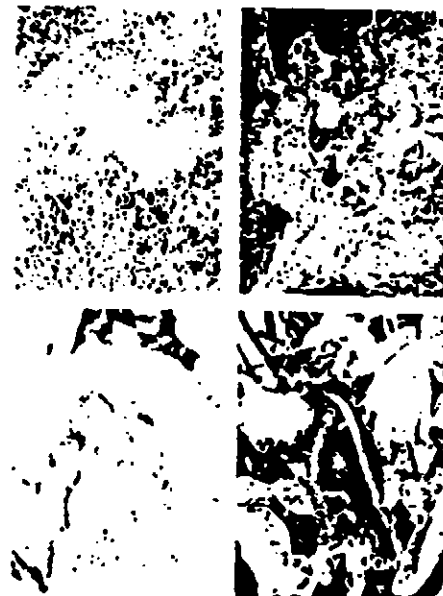

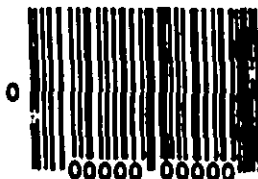

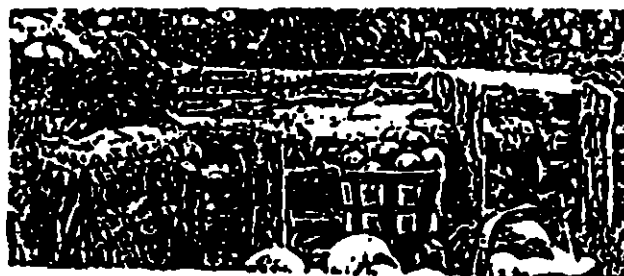

ods of wet weather or severe disease condition.  
Do not mow or water after treatment until lawn is  
thoroughly dry.

**BICHORONA LAWNS IN CALIFORNIA ONLY:** To  
cure Alternaria Leaf Spot use 1 pint of material in  
5 to 10 gallons per 500 sq. ft. Spray on 7-14 day

intervals of application. Under severe disease  
conditions spray on a 7 day schedule and use  
higher rate. Use lower rates when disease condi-  
tions are light to moderate.

**ORNAMENTALS:**  
Lawn and Garden Fungicide is recommend-  
ed for the control of a number of diseases of orna-  
mentals. Apply at first sign of disease and repeat  
at 7 to 14 day intervals throughout the season.  
Application should be thorough to obtain adequate

**GERANIUMS:** Botrytis Blight use 9 tablespoons  
per gallon of water.

**IRIS:** Botrytis Blight and leaf spot use 9 table-  
spoons per gallon of water.

**ROSES:** Black spot and Moslem Blight use 6  
tablespoons per gallon of water.

**ZINIBALS:** Powdery mildew use 9 tablespoons  
per gallon of water.

**PHLOXENOROUS:** For control of Phytophthora Blight  
and Botrytis leaf spot use 9 tablespoons per  
gallon of water. Apply at 7 day intervals.

**VEGETABLES:**  
Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower,  
For Alternaria leaf spot (Southeastern states only)  
and Downy mildew apply after transplant and when  
conditions favor disease development. Mix 3 table-  
spoons in 5-15 gallons of water and apply to  
500 sq. ft. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals or as  
necessary to maintain control.

**MILDS (Cocksfoot, Honeydew, Mistletoe):**  
For Anthracnose, downy mildew apply when condi-  
tions favor disease development. Use 6 table

spoons in 5-15 gallons of water per 500 sq. ft.  
Repeat at 7 day intervals.

**PUMPKIN, SQUASH (Summer and Winter),  
WATERMELONS:** For Anthracnose and downy mil-  
dew apply when conditions favor disease develop-  
ment. Use 6 tablespoons per 5-15 gallons of  
water per 500 sq. ft. of garden area. Repeat at 7  
day intervals.

**TOMATOES:** For Anthracnose, early and late blights,  
gray leaf spot, gray/leaf mold use 4 tablespoons  
in 5-15 gallons of water per 500 sq. ft. Begin when  
disease threatens and repeat at 7-10 day intervals.
