NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered but only in conjunction with atropine.

2. Under the Environmental Hazards section, change the statement, "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. " to "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
