The following information is being provided in connection with
the registration of this product under section 24(c)(1) of the Federal Insecticide,
Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), 1974, and the amendments
thereof.

1. Submit/enter all data required for registration/
re-registration of your product under FIFRA section
24(c)(1) when the agency, in writing, will require
of similar products to submit such data.
2. Have Wilbur Ellis, Inc. submit authorization for this
agency to use their data to support the subject
application. We have no record of receiving a letter
from them authorizing the use of their data.
3. Revise the directions for use section of the label
as follows:
 - a. for use on wheat seed add the following restriction:
"Do not allow livestock to graze or feed on treated
green wheat forage."
 - b. for use on soybean seed add the following restriction:
"Do not graze or feed treated soybean vines or hay
to livestock."
 - c. for this product add the restriction: "Do not
tank mix or apply in combination with copper fungicides."

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4. Submit five (5) printed copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
5. Submit a new Confidential Statement of Formula that reflects the upper and lower limits of the active ingredients in this product, in accordance with FR Notice 91-2.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FRNA Section 6(c). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A true copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Danger

Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Remove and separately launder clothing before reuse. Wash with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not clean equipment or dispose of equipment washwaters in a manner that will contaminate water resources. Do not apply directly to water areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Exposed treated seeds may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. In the event that treated seeds are spilled and cannot be salvaged, completely cover them with soil. Dispose of all excess treated seeds by burial away from bodies of water.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

AGROSOL Flowable is a seed treatment fungicide specially prepared for commercial seed treatment. When used at the correct dosage rates, AGROSOL Flowable will protect soybean and wheat seeds from soil and seed borne diseases that cause damping-off, seed decay and seedling blights. The systemic action of the thiabendazole present in Agrosol will suppress pod and stem blight (*Phomopsis* spp.) of soybeans during germination and early seedling stages.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE PRECAUTIONS

SHAKE OR STIR WELL BEFORE USING. Use at temperatures above 40°F.

SOYBEANS: Use AGROSOL Flowable in liquid and slurry treaters at the rate of 1.5 fl. oz. per bushel of soybean seed (2.5 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of soybean seed).

WHEAT: Use AGROSOL Flowable in liquid and slurry treaters at the rate of 1.5 fl. oz. per bushel of wheat seed (2.5 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of wheat seed).

NOTE: The purchaser of this product is responsible for insuring that all seed treated with this product is adequately dyed with a suitable color to prevent its accidental use as a food for man or feed for animals. Refer to 21 CFR. Part 2.25. Any dye added must be cleared for use under CFR, Part 180.1001.

Avoid contamination of feed, food and foodstuffs.

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Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Seed commercially treated with Agrosol Flowable must be labelled in accordance with all applicable requirements of the Federal and State seed laws.

Mixers/loaders when mixing and loading this product must wear a long-sleeve shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or a face shield and a chemically resistant apron.

AFTER WORK: Take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with captan must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store above 32°F. Product stored at lower temperature will reconstitute to satisfactory utility if warmed to approximately 70°F and thoroughly shaken or stirred before use. Store treated seed in a ventilated place away from water, food and feed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
