PRODUCT INFORMATION

GRANOL Plus is a special seed treatment formulation containing a combination of maneb and thiabendazole fungicides, plus the insecticide lindane. When used at the correct use rate, GRANOL Plus protects wheat against the seed-borne disease Stinking Smut (Bunt). It also protects wheat against certain seed and soil borne diseases such as Root Rot and Seedling Blight during germination and the early seedling stages. GRANOL Plus also provides temporary

planter box application. It is to be mixed directly with the seed in the box, either as it is run into the box, or by spreading the treatment over the leveled seed and thoroughly mixing the treatment into the seed with an axe handle or paddle (an axe handle or paddle for seed treatment purposes only). This product can also be applied with suitable automated application equipment to give thorough uniform coverage to the seed. See application instructions on this label.

#### PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Application Instructions: Wheat -  
Use 2 oz. per Bushel

Use only recommended rates. Lower amounts may not give the desired control. Higher amounts may cause seed injury. Seed should be well cured, dry and cleaned before treatment. For maximum benefits avoid deep seeding and exceptionally early sowing under poor growing conditions. GRANOL Plus should be thoroughly mixed with seed to uniformly coat the seed.

1. Automatic Seed Treaters - equipment that meters the proper amount of GRANOL Plus and uniformly mixes it as seed is tumbled into the planter or drill box. Be sure to calibrate the equipment properly to set proper amount of GRANOL Plus on the seed.
2. Drill or Planter Box Application - Place and level one-half of the seed in the drill or planter box, then uniformly sprinkle one-half of the total GRANOL Plus required. Mix thoroughly with an axe handle or paddle (an axe handle or paddle for seed treatment purpose only), then fill the box with seed and sprinkle the remaining one-half of the GRANOL Plus over the seed and thoroughly mix until the seed is uniformly coated.
