Subject: Label Revisions - Safe Handling
Agrosol Plus Cereal Seed Treatment Fungicide
EPA Registration No. 2935-474
Your Submission Dated August 21, 1991

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. In the ingredient statement move thiabendazole before the chemical name.
- b. The additional precautionary statements must be moved to the Precautionary Statements Section on page 2 of the label.
- c. Update the Environmental Hazards Statement to read:

Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The additional brand name "Granox Plus Systemic Seed Treatment Fungicide for Wheat" is acceptable. The label text must be identical to the basic registration except for the brand name.

Precautionary Review Section / Registration Support Branch could only locate acute toxicity studies performed with the individual active ingredients. The acute toxicity studies required by Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 158 for this end-use product will have to be submitted or cited at reregistration or when the Agency may require them. Further label revisions may be required following the submission of the acute toxicity studies.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. May cause irritation of nose, throat, eyes, and skin. Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. See First Aid (Practical Treatment section).

HANDLERS (MIXERS, LOADERS, AND APPLICATORS) MUST WEAR THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT: a long-sleeve shirt and long pants or a coverall, chemical resistant gloves, shoes, socks, and goggles or a face shield. During mixing and loading, a chemical resistant apron must also be worn.

IMPORTANT! Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking or drinking. Always wash hands and arms with soap and water before using the toilet.

After work take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes. Do not use contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment drenched with maneb must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

Remove and separately launder clothing and decontaminate shoes before reuse.]

Do not treat indoors unless there is thorough ventilation.

Avoid contamination of feed, food and foodstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, induce vomiting by drinking one or two large glasses of water and touch the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. Get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with clean water for at least 15 minutes and then get medical attention.

If on skin, wash with plenty of soap and water. If skin irritation persists, get medical attention. If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. Obtain medical attention.

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters. Exposed treated seed may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Cover or incorporate spilled treated seed. Dispose of all excess treated seeds by burial away from bodies of water.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Keep away from fire and sparks. Store in a dry place. Do not allow to become wet or overheated in storage. This may bring on chemical changes which will impair the fungicidal effectiveness of the product and may also produce flammable vapours.
