The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you revise your label as follows:

Under "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS", replace the second sentence with "Do not apply directly to water to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."

The precautionary statements must appear under the "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" section of your label.

Furthermore, the Precautionary Review Section has been unable to locate any acute toxicity studies performed with the subject product. Only studies on the individual active ingredients could be found. Acute oral, acute dermal, acute inhalation, eye irritation, and dermal sensitization studies must be submitted or cited to complete the acute toxicity battery for the subject product at reregistration or when the Agency requires them. These studies are necessary to accurately define the risk associated with acute exposure to this product. Following receipt of the required data, the proper precautionary language will be determined.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. May cause irritation of nose, - throat, eyes, and skin. Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. See First Aid (Practical Treatment section).

HANDLERS (MIXERS, LOADERS, AND APPLICATORS) MUST WEAR THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT: a long-sleeve shirt and long pants or a coverall; chemical resistant gloves; shoes, socks, and goggles or a face shield. During mixing and loading, a chemical resistant apron must also be worn.

IMPORTANT: Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking, or drinking. Always wash hands and arms with soap and water before using the toilet.

After work take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes. Do not use contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment drenched with maneb must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

DRENCHED CLOTHING CANNOT BE ADEQUATELY DECONTAMINATED.

Treat seed in a well ventilated place.

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Seed commercially treated with GRANOX Plus Flowable must be labeled in accordance with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, induce vomiting by drinking one or two large glasses of water and then touch back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. Get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with clean water for at least 15 minutes and then get medical attention. If on skin, wash with soap and water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters. Exposed treated seeds may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Cover or incorporate spilled treated seed. Dispose of all excess treated seeds by burial away from bodies of water.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

GRANOX Plus Flowable is a special seed treatment formulation of maneb, and thiabendazole fungicides which, when used at the correct dosage rate, protects wheat against the seed-borne disease Stinking Smut (Bunt) of Wheat. It also protects wheat against certain seed and soil-borne diseases causing Root Rot and Seedling Blight.
