DIRECTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

Apply at recommended rates. Lower amounts may not give the desired control. Higher amounts may cause seed injury. Seed should be well cured, dried and cleaned before treatment. For maximum benefits avoid deep seeding and exceptionally early sowing under poor growing conditions.
 NOTE: The purchaser of this product is responsible for insuring that all seed treated with this product are adequately dyed with a suitable color to prevent its accidental use as food for man or for animals. Refer to 21 CFR, Part 2.25. Any dye added must be cleared for use under 40 CFR, Part 160.1001.
 Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
STORAGE: Store above 0°F. Product stored at a lower temperature can be restored for use by warming to approximately 70°F and thoroughly shaking or stirring before use. Always store product in original container in a cool, dry and well ventilated place. Do not use or store product near heat or open flame.
 Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store treated seed in a well ventilated place away from water, food or feed. Do not allow to become wet in storage.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. May cause irritation of nose, throat, eyes, and skin. Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. See First Aid (Practical Treatment section).

HANDLERS (MIXERS, LOADERS, AND APPLICATORS) MUST WEAR THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT: a long-sleeve shirt and long pants or a coverall; chemical resistant gloves; shoes; socks; and goggles or a face shield. During mixing and loading, a chemical resistant apron must also be worn.

Avoid the inhalation of dust from treated seed. Wilbur-Ellis Company recommends the use of a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Safety and Health Administration (formerly U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health under provisions of 30 CFR Part II.

Avoid contact with eyes by wearing goggles while handling treated seed.

Remove and separately launder clothing and decontaminate shoes before reuse.

Treat seed in a well ventilated place.

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, processed for oil. Seed commercially treated with GRANOX Plus Flowable must be labeled in accordance with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, induce vomiting by drinking one or two large glasses of water and then touch back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or giving anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. Get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with water for at least 15 minutes and then get medical attention. If on skin, wash with soap and water.

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters. Exposed treated seeds may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Cover or incorporate spilled treated seed. Dispose of all spilled treated seed by burial away from bodies of water.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

GRANOX Plus Flowable is a seed treatment formulation of maneb and thiabendazole fungicides which, when used at the correct dosage rate, protects wheat against the seed-borne diseases Stinking Smut (Bunt) of Wheat. It also protects wheat against other seed-borne diseases causing Root Rot and Seeding Blight.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL CAREFULLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS, AND WITH APPLICABLE STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

STIR WELL BEFORE USE. Use at temperatures above 0°F.
