## STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, induce vomiting by drinking 1 or 2 large glasses of water and then touch back of throat with finger. Get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with plenty of clean water for at least 15 minutes and then get medical attention. If on skin, remove any contaminated clothing and wash with plenty of soap and water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### WARNING

May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust, vapor, or spray mist. Causes eye and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. ### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, to surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washings. Exposed treated seeds may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. If treated seeds are spilled and cannot be salvaged, completely bury with soil. Dispose of all excess treated seeds by burial away from body of water.

## PRODUCT INFORMATION

AGROSOL T is a seed treatment fungicide specially prepared for commercial seed treatment. AGROSOL T, when used at the correct rate, will protect wheat and soybean seeds from soil and seed borne diseases that cause damping off, seed decay, and seedling blights. In soybeans, AGROSOL T protects against infection with F. and S. Stem Blight (Phomopsis spp.) during germination and early seedling stages.

## APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Thoroughly mix and agitate AGROSOL T in the container and mix tank before use. (room temperatures above 40°F for best seed application results.) Use AGROSOL T in liquid and slurry treaters at the following rates:

Soybeans: 6.6 fluid ounces per 100 pounds of seed  
(4 fluid ounces per bushel).

Wheat: 6.6 fluid ounces per 100 pounds of seed  
(4 fluid ounces per bushel).

NOTE: The purchaser of this product is responsible for insuring that all seed treated with this product are adequately dyed with a suitable color to prevent its accidental use as food for man or feed for animals. Refer to 21 CFR, Part 2.25. Any dye added must be cleared for use under 40 CFR, Part 180.1001.

Always wash hands and arms with soap and water before using toilet facilities.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
